Venue: FHI 360

FHI 360 is located at 1825 Connecticut Ave NW, 8th Floor, Washington, DC 20009. Garage parking is located at 2005 Florida Avenue, between Connecticut Avenue and T Street and is open between the hours of 7am and 11pm.

FHI 360 is centrally located in the [Dupont Circle](#) neighborhood of DC and within a short walking distance of several restaurants, coffee shops, pharmacies, and shops. There is a Rite Aid housed in the same building as FHI 360.

Arrival and Departure from DCA/IAD/BWI

Washington Reagan (DCA) is accessible via the Blue and Yellow Lines at the National Airport Metro Station. The Blue Line transfers to the Red Line at Metro Center Station and the Yellow Line transfers to the Red Line at Gallery Place Chinatown Station.

Dulles (IAD) is accessible in two ways:

Arrival

1. Take Metrobus route 5A to the Rosslyn Metrorail station (Orange, Silver, and Blue Lines). To find out when the bus leaves the airport, [see the 5A schedule](#).
2. Take the Washington Flyer bus to the Wiehle-Reston East Metrorail station on the Silver Line. To find out when the Washington Flyer leaves the airport and its cost, go to the [Washington Flyer website](#).

Departure

1. Take Metrobus route 5A from L'Enfant Plaza Metrorail station (Orange, Silver, Blue, Yellow, and Green Lines) or the Rosslyn Metrorail station (Orange, Silver, and Blue Lines). To find out when the bus leaves each of these stations for the airport, [see the 5A schedule](#).



2. Take the Silver Line to the Wiehle-Reston East Metrorail station where you can take the Washington Flyer bus service to the airport. To find out when the Washington Flyer leaves the stations and its cost, go to the [Washington Flyer website](#).

Baltimore Washington (BWI) is accessible via the [MARC Train](#):

Arrival: Take a free shuttle from the airport to the BWI Marshall Rail Station and take the MARC train to Union Station. From there, you can transfer to Metro's Red Line.

Departure: Union Station is accessible via several bus lines (the [Circulator](#) is a great option) and via the Red Line. The MARC Train provides service to the BWI Marshall Rail Station, where free shuttles are available to the airport terminal.

Public Transportation: Metro & Bus

Dupont Circle Station, located on the Red Line, is the closest metro station and is approximately an eight-minute walk from FHI 360. Take the Q Street exit out of the station and walk Northbound on Connecticut Avenue.

Connecticut Ave NW & Leroy Place NW is the closest bus stop, serving bus lines 42, 43, H1, L1, and L2.
